## Currency

All fees listed are in US Dollars.

## Application Fee

A non-refundable, \$145 (\$100 for New York - Juilliard, New York - Manhattan; New York - Riverdale, and Garden City) application fee is required with your completed application in order to process your enrollment.

## Tuition Fee

Tuition fees are as listed below. To take advantage of the long-term, discounted programs, you must pay the tuition for all sessions before starting your program at ELS.

## Housing Fee

All housing fees are listed on pages 2-4 of this document. Housing prices are subject to change. A housing reservation deposit of \$200 per session (\$400 for New York - Manhattan) is required for each session ELS reserves your accommodations.

## Student Health Plan Fee

All ELS students must have medical insurance coverage while in the US. If you cannot provide evidence of sufficient coverage, in English, for medical expenses incurred while studying in the US you must purchase the ELS Student Health Plan.
